

## Emergency and Critical Care Internship Position at The Ralph Veterinary Referral Centre

We are looking for two dedicated and enthusiastic veterinary surgeons with a keen interest in and passion for veterinary emergency and critical care to start a one-year ECC internship at The Ralph Veterinary Referral Centre in January 2023!

The successful candidate will join our large ECC team, including four ACVECC Diplomates, five ECC Staff Clinicians, two ECC interns and nine highly-skilled nurses. At The Ralph you will have hands-on experience with procedures such as mechanical ventilation, high-flow nasal oxygen, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, point of care ultrasound, line placement, drain placement, transfusion medicine, and more. We are a true veterinary intensive care unit with a high caseload of critically ill animals.

During the internship you will work in close contact with Diplomates in many disciplines including Anaesthesia and Analgesia, Cardiology, Dentistry, Diagnostic Imaging, Internal Medicine, Oncology, Ophthalmology, Orthopaedic surgery and Soft Tissue surgery. You will also work with our excellent Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation team who have a keen interest in providing their service to ICU patients.

As an ECC intern, you will be an integral part of the team and will have supervised primary case responsibility from the start of your internship. You will be involved in all aspects of your patient's care, including consultation, examination, developing diagnostic and treatment plans, instrumentation, carer communications, and writing of discharge reports. You will work a mixture of days, weekends, and nights, always working alongside a Diplomate or Staff Clinician. The internship programme also includes regular, structured, dedicated time for teaching activity.

The Ralph is an independent multidisciplinary specialist referral centre for dogs and cats located in the beautiful Marlow, Bucks, west of London (just off the A404 with easy access from the M4 and M40 motorways).

The Ralph is a workplace that focuses on core values, culture, vision and mission. We emphasise kindness, compassion and empathy for all our communities.
